Question of the Week

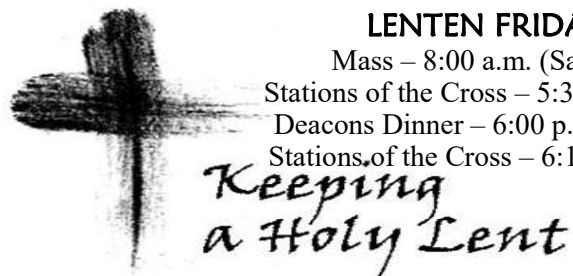
For Children: God wants your faith to result in good living. What steps can you take during Lent to make sure that happens?
