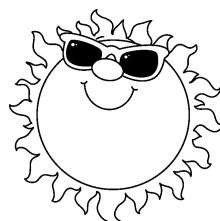

PERFUME AND COLOGNE

It was recently brought to our attention that we have a number of parishioners who attend Mass who suffer from asthma, COPD and other conditions that make breathing difficult. These conditions make people extremely sensitive to the scent of perfume and cologne, and can cause breathing attacks. Last weekend several parishioners had to leave Mass because of the overwhelming scent of perfume and cologne that was worn by fellow parishioners.

We are asking people to please be aware of the amount of scent you are wearing. When people wear the same fragrance for a long time, their scent receptors can become immune to it, and they don't realize how strong the scent is to other people. If possible, please forego the use of perfume and cologne when attending Mass, as the closeness in the pews only exaggerates the condition. Thank you for being considerate of your fellow parishioners.

ARE YOU BEING CALLED?

INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults undergo educational and spiritual preparation to help them determine whether they are being called to join the Roman Catholic Church. This program includes the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation & Holy Eucharist.

The RCIA program is led by a team who will help guide participants through the faith journey. Participants will have individual sponsors to pray with, and to discuss topics throughout their learning & discovering process.
