Question of the Week

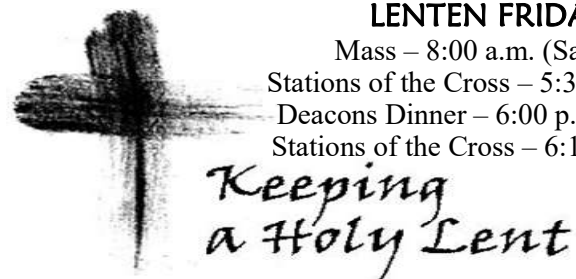
For Children: When you feel tempted to do wrong, how do you remain strong in your faith?
