WEEKLY REFLECTION

Question of the Week

For Children: If someone were to ask you, “who is Jesus?” how would you answer?

For Youth: How are you able to see through all the busyness, the distractions, and the din of today’s world to really see Christ as he makes himself present today? Where do you see him or experience his presence?

For Adults: In the gospel today, John tells us who Jesus is for him. If someone were to ask you, how would you answer this question: Who Jesus is for you?

Liturgy of the Word

All of today’s readings are about the mission that God has for those who follow God. Isaiah speaks of being God’s servant; Saint Paul says he was called to be an apostle; and John the Baptist, himself a servant of God, identifies Jesus as the Son of God. As we hear these sacred scriptures proclaimed, let us make the refrain of the responsorial psalm our own prayer: “Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.”
